What are Primary Care Leadership Collaboratives?

Primary Care Leadership Collaboratives (PCLC) are designed to support local teams and Primary Care Networks (PCNs) in developing leadership capabilities in each of the east of England [Integrated Care Systems](#) and [Sustainability and Transformation Partnerships \(see map\)](#).

We are seeking to support up to twelve collaboratives of between 3 to 5 participants in each collaborative; likely to be a practice manager, practice nurse and GP/GDP but potentially including other senior colleagues in practices, developing [Primary Care Networks](#), and other local organisations. Individual practices or PCNs can form their own collaborative to attend and could use the programme to develop any quality improvement initiatives within their organisation and network. We anticipate each collaborative will already be working together to improve health and health outcomes for communities. Our goal is to enable improvement, integration and innovation across ICS/STPs through the collaborative, sharing a common purpose and vision of primary care and future outcomes for communities.

Overview of programme components

- The programme provides a blended learning approach combining the opportunity for group discussion, interaction and peer to peer learning with a number of guest speakers on topics and themes such as team leadership, improvement methods, innovation and system working, project work and reading resources.
- **Three impact days: Wednesday 16th October, Wednesday 11th December 2019 and Wednesday 29th January 2020**
- **Venue - Holiday Inn, Impington, Cambs**
- Access to coaching and/or mentoring.
- Undertaking your 360 Healthcare Leadership
- Online dedicated microsite.

Intended outcome

To support, develop and improve leadership capacity and capability within Primary Care and Primary Care networks, building resilience and sustainability in the workforce. The programme also aims to enhance collaborative system wide working to support transformation.

Step 3:


- Successful collaboratives will be notified by **Monday 16th September 2019**
